### Job Description

*Lyric Theatre Company's "LyricKids" Summer Musical Theatre Camps provides high quality, affordable performance opportunities for youth aged 8 to 15. In the course of a week's rehearsal, the creative team--all qualified teaching artists--engage students in process-oriented skill building as dancers, actors, storytellers, singers, and cast-mates. Each individual's strengths are assessed and utilized by the creative team with a strong focus on building confidence and having fun!*

The Summer Camp Intern position will offer a responsible, resourceful and creative young adult the opportunity to participate in the planning and execution of our LyricKids camps. With direction and supervision from the camp creative team, the Summer Intern will have the opportunity to participate in all technical aspects of each week-long camp including costumes, props, and other production elements, as well as assisting with pre-camp administrative and design work. The Summer Intern will be a valuable member of the production team, as well as a hardworking camp counselor to students aged 8 to 15.

#### Role and Responsibilities

- A student with experience and/or interest in technical theatre, art, leadership, children and/or teaching.
- A student who is at least 15 years old.
- A student who has/is:
  - The ability to take initiative;
  - Comfortable working with different people;
  - Comfortable in a leadership role;
  - Able to prioritize and complete tasks under a deadline;
  - Able to follow directions.
- Works closely with the team to make artistic vision complete re: costumes, small props, make-up etc, sound, stage management, lights within a predetermined budget.
- Supervises participants in technical work time.
- Supervises strike and helps return props, costumes, and other items borrowed for the production.
